The following members of the boys' track and field team participated in the District I Championships on May 14th in Coatesville. In arguably, the toughest district in the state, they competed with not only some of the best in the state, but the US as well.

4x800m Relay: Bond, Colon, Moser and Brennan (placed 25th out of 32)

400m: Wolfe: placed 14th out of 20

Eric Diestelow qualified for the 1600m finals. In the qualifying run, Eric broke the 1600m school record of 4:19.29 held by Duriel Hardy (2006) by running a 4:18.76. He will run at 12:55 on Saturday, May 16th. Eric and Cole Baldyga (javelin) will look to earn a berth to the PIAA State Championships at Shippensburg next week by either placing in the Top 5 (automatic bid) or by placing in the Top 8 and hitting the state qualifying standard.

The Boys' Track and Field team is led this season by seniors Eric Diestelow, David Bond, Jake Wolfe, Hasan Leonard-Hakim and Dan Tyler. At the Rustin Invitational held on April 1st, Eric Diestelow placed 1st and qualified for the PIAA District I Championship meet with a time of

9:40.97. He also joined with teammates David Bond, Victor Colon and Danny Brennan to place 2nd and running a season best time of 8:23.59 in the 4 x 800 m relay. Jake Wolfe ran an outdoor personal record in the open 400m dash by placing 3rd and running 52.09. In the field, Dan Tyler continued his strong start in the triple jump by placing 3rd with a jump of 40'3 inches.
